1. In accordance with Para 2(a) of Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence letter No MoD/C/1072/22/MS (Q/MS-42005) dated 01 Sep 2006 and letter No A/36105/GS/MT-6/D(GS-II) dated 03 Sep 2014, the next RIMC examination for admission to **Class VIII** in the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun for the **Jan 2018** term will be held at the selected centres in the country on **01(Thu) and 02 (Fri) Jun 2017**. The candidates will be examined in the following subjects: -

(c)	General Knowledge Written Paper	75
(d)	Interview, designed primarily to test the intelligence, personality etc of candidates and not proficiency in English.	50 (Who have qualified in the written examination)

Note:

- ◆ As per Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter No A/36105/GS/MT-6/D(GS-II) dated 03 Sep 2014, the wards of Central Government employees can undertake their exam and viva-voce in the place of posting of employee/ domicile state. However, their domicile will be as per original domicile state and accordingly, their candidature will also be considered as per the state of domicile.
- ◆ The interviews will be held for only those candidates who pass the written exam; their list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval of MT Directorate.
- ◆ It is mandatory for all successful candidates to join RIMC within 10 days of date of commencement of term (issue of joining instructions for reserve candidates), otherwise his candidature will be cancelled and next reserve candidate will be called to join. Results and joining instruction will be regularly updates in RIMC website. It is candidate's responsibility to check the status regularly.

2. The Examination in **English** (1000-1200hrs) and **Mathematics** (1400-1530hrs) shall be conducted on **01(Thu) Jun 2017** and **General Knowledge** paper (1000-1100hrs) on **02 (Fri) Jun 2017**. The interview date shall be on **10 (Tue) Oct 2017**. Mathematics and General Knowledge papers may be answered either in Hindi or in English. The examination will be held simultaneously for all the candidates, whether they answer the Question papers in Hindi or English. Minimum pass marks in each paper including interview will be 50% and if the candidate fails to secure 50% marks in any paper he will be declared ineligible for admission. The selection of the candidates will be purely on

Only boys are eligible to apply for admission to the RIMC, Dehradun. The candidate should either be studying in Class VII or passed Class VII from any recognized school at the time of admission to the RIMC, i.e. on 01 Jan 2018. They should not be less than 11½ years in age but should not have attained the age of 13 yrs as on 01 Jan 2018, i.e., they should not be born earlier than 02 Jan 2005 and not later than 01 Jul 2006. The applicants should be informed that no application for change in the date of birth, from that originally given by them would be entertained later on by the college authorities.

Applications in duplicate on prescribed form accompanied by documents to be attached with application form two passport size photographs, Domicile Certificate of the candidate, Birth Certificate (issued by Municipal Corporation/Grain Panchayat), SC/ ST Certificate and Certificate from principal of the School in original with photograph on it attested stating date of birth and in which Class the student is studying. Application forms should reach the respective state Govts (as specified in the press note) of which their parents/guardians are domicile of, by 31 Mar 2017. For wards of Central Government employees, in order to verify the antecedents of such candidates, the State (where such candidates intend taking the written test) are free to ask for service certificates over and above the routine documentation. The States where the candidates appear must also satisfy themselves with respect to place of duty of the parent/guardian. Other than the above, states are to ensure that no other candidate must be allowed to appear for the written examination in a state other than which the candidate is domicile of. However, in case selected the vacancy to be counted towards their respective home state only.

5. Only the candidates finally selected after the viva voce will undergo a medical examination at selected Military Hospitals and only the candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC. The medical examination of the candidates forms only a part of the system of selection and does not include the final selection. Candidates should not therefore, consider themselves finally selected until Govt order to this effect is issued and call up notices are sent to them by the Govt.

I am to request that necessary arrangements, as in the previous years, may please be made for holding the examination in the states and the name (with tele, fax numbers and e-mail address) of the officers nominated for conducting the examination may be communicated to the Commandant, RIMC, Dehradun by 15 Apr 2017. ADEQUATE PUBLICITY may please be given regarding this examination in the local papers at least twice or thrice through the press release before 23 Jan 2017. In case State Govts desire that the applications should be submitted through the District Officer, this may be made clear in the notices to be issued in the local papers. Application forms may be obtained by the candidates directly on payment from RIMC.

7. In accordance with the procedure laid down in this Ministry's letter No. A/35079/GS/MT-6(A)/453-B/D (GS-II) dated 05 April 1989, the answer books in respect of the candidates along with the application forms may please be forwarded at the end of the Examination, in a sealed cover to the Commandant, RIMC, Dehradun, Uttarakhand. Pin- 248003.

9. The viva-voce test is to be conducted by the State Govts on 10 (Tue) Oct 2017 for only those candidates who have qualified in the written examination. The candidates will be informed of result of written examination by early Sep 2017. The constitution of the selection board is as prescribed in Para 8 of the regulation governing RIMC and shall be as follows: -

- (a) Chief Secretary to the Govt or in case the State Govt so desires any other Secretary of the State Govt nominated by him.
- (b) Two military Officers, one of them should not be below the rank of Lt Col. These officers will be detailed as far as possible from the nearest Military Station and all expenses of TA and DA etc will be borne by the Govt of India.
- (c) The State Director of Public Institutions or Director of Education or some senior officer nominated by him.
- (d) Where practicable, a member of the State Public Service Commission.

10. The result of the viva- voce must be sent in a sealed envelope to the Commandant, RIMC, and Dehradun immediately after the conduct of viva voce. Also, the same must be conveyed by fax and email the same day. The fax No of RIMC is 0135-2754260 and the email id is rimcollege@yahoo.com.



PRESS RELEASE FOR NEXT RIMC ADMISSION TEST IN JUN 2017
PRESS INFORMATION BUREAU (DEFENCE WING) GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

1. The Rashtriya Indian Military College is an Inter-Services Institution and a Category 'A' establishment of the Ministry of Defence. The College was established in 1922 with the primary aim of preparing the boys for entry into Defence Services and to provide quality all round education to young boys.

2. Applications are invited for boys **only** for admission to **Class VIII** in the the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehradun (UK) for **JAN 2018 Term** which will be conducted at selected centres on **01(Thu) and 02 (Fri) Jun 2017**.

3. **Entry Age-** Candidates (boys only) appearing for the above test should not be less than **11½ years** in age but should not have attained the age of **13 years** as on **01 Jan 2018**, i.e., they should have been born not earlier than **02 Jan 2005** and not later than **01 Jul 2006**.

4. **Educational Qualifications-** Candidates should either be studying in **Class VII** or **passed Class VII** from any recognized school at the time of admission to the RIMC, i.e. on **01 JAN 2018**.

5. **Scheme of Examination-** The examination comprises of:-

(a) **Written Examination-** The written part of the examination will consist of three papers, namely, **English** (1000-1200hrs) and **Mathematics** (1400-1530hrs) shall be conducted on **01 (Thu) Jun 2017** and **General Knowledge paper** (1000-1100hrs) on **02 (Fri) Jun 2017**. Minimum pass marks in each paper is 50%.

(b) **Viva Voce-** The interview date shall be **10 (Tue) Oct 2017**, and interview will be held for only those candidates who qualify in the written exam. Minimum pass marks in interview is 50% and the date, venue for interview will be intimated to them by respective State early by **Sep 2017**. Intelligence and personality of the candidates will be tested in the interview.

(c) **Medical Examination-** All the candidates qualified after interview will undergo a medical examination at selected Military Hospitals and only those candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC. The medical examination of the candidates forms only a part of the system of selection and does not imply the final selection.

- ❖ As per Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter No A/36105/GS/MT-6/D(GS-II) dated 03 Sep 2014, the wards of Central Government employees can undertake their exam and viva-voce in the place of posting of employee/ domicile state. However, their domicile will be as per original domicile state and accordingly, their candidature will also be considered as per the state of domicile.
 - ❖ The interviews will be held for only those candidates who pass the written exam; their list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval of MT Directorate.
 - ❖ It is mandatory for all successful candidates to join RIMC within 10 days of date of commencement of term (issue of joining instructions for reserve candidates), otherwise his candidature will be cancelled and next reserve candidate will be called to join. 6. **Examination Centres-** Examination centres are generally located in the state capitals or in cities/towns as per advertised.
7. **Fee-** Fees at RIMC is heavily subsidized by the Central Govt. The fee is presently **Rs. 42,400/-** per year. It may increase from time to time. At the time of entry a Security Deposit of **Rs. 20,000/-** is to be made. This is refunded when the boy passes out.
8. **Scholarships-** Scholarships are granted by various state Govts to meritorious students. The amount of scholarships varies from state to state and is in between **Rs. 10,000/-** to **Rs. 20,000/-** per annum. Continuation of Scholarship once granted by the state is subject to merit, income and discipline of the cadet and his performance during the year.
